PECAN+ Capture The Flag (CTF) is a free, national competition event designed to develop and nurture the interest of Australian high school students in **cyber security** skills and practices. PECAN+ CTF is a collaborative initiative that brings together Australian higher education and vocational institutions, cyber security industry, Government, teachers and students around the aim of raising cyber security awareness, skills and aspirations.

Our goal is to support cyber security-curious high school-aged students, from diverse backgrounds, in their engagement with cyber security skills, concepts and careers, and to foster connections between education bodies, higher education students and the greater cyber security ecosystem.

In a collaborative model, PECAN+ CTF activations are hosted at locations across Australia, with support and involvement from local higher education institutions and agencies, Government and Industry representatives. It is a months long initiative that raises cyber security skills nationally, through training and technical workshops, industry and government presentations and practice opportunities which hone skills, before culminating in a final, challenging national “Capture The Flag” style Competition event.

Further, the initiative enables university and TAFE students to develop their technical and cyber skill as they support competitors and create cyber security challenges, as well as provides forums for connections and networking with the great cyber security ecosystem through the involvement of Industry and Government supporters. PECAN+ CTF is designed to be holistic, different, has something for all skill and interest levels, and aims to grow the next generation of cyber security talent, with a strong focus on diversity and gender inclusion.

In its seventh year, PECAN+ CTF 2025 saw 115 Teams (450 national student registrations) compete in Perth, Darwin, Adelaide, Brisbane, Coomera, Toowoomba, Townsville, Canberra, Wollongong and Victoria. We look to grow PECAN+ CTF in its size and impact in 2026.


